### New business.

Ron discussed about a Work Shop Weekend to be held in May or June at CHSS

Bob Ramsay said that he would look into the use of CHSS and contact the shop teacher there. He would also check into adult Ed centers.

It was also discussed if the workshop should be at members shops, this is a possibility but CHSS is preferred.

There was 8 members showing interest to assist with this.

Laurier asked all the members at the Dec meeting what they would like to see for each meeting next year and encouraged all of us to think about a project for each meeting that would be set out for the year. He also asked anyone to step forward to do demo's for the meetings so that one person would not be doing the entire demo's.

So here are some things that the members would like to see.

- 1) Spindle Turning – multiple parts, like a 3-legged stool.
- 2) Cutting and reassembling on and off the lathe.
- 3) Surface figure carving – how to leave a raised figure.
- 4) Segmented turnings.
- 5) Laminated turning (i.e.) contrasting woods and colours –what species turn well in common.
- 6) Jig for the lathe – router mounts and drilling guides.
- 7) Sharpening with jigs.

Also here are some demo's and projects for the guild meetings for 09

- 1) Square edge bowl.
- 2) Segmented piece.
- 3) Wedding Goblet c/w captured rings.
- 4) Inside/ Outside turning.

- 5) Hollow vessel with boring bar and laser.
- 6) Grinding and sharpening your tools.
- 7) Steady rest for bowls and spindles.
- 8) Stone turning (Bob's house)
- 9) Box turning.

Ron C did a demo on a needle box and a winged pine bowl.
