 - Laurier gave a report about the tilt bins from Home Hardware on the Hart and they still have not said how many they want to let us have.
 - He also gave a reminder about the 2 Rivers Gallery showing in July and told members to get a least 2 pieces ea ready for the show.
 - There was a really nice showing of spheres which was the project for this month with a few additions.
 - Bob R told the members that the guild is now a member of the CAC (community arts council) of PG. This was also funded by Bob and not the guild (thanks very much Bob)
- He also said that any paid up member can now sell their ware's at Studio 2880, but you have to get your Art (pieces) critiqued by 2880 before you can sell there. What you have to is take 3 pieces down to 2880 to have this done. Along with this membership we get to use the meeting rooms there that can hold up to 75 people. We will also be able to go into Studio Fair, but if you go into that you will not be able to go to UNBC Craft Fair. There are some differences of opinion about this and Bob is going to get clarification on this.
- Ron C gave a small report about the Woodturners Fun Weekend. They have now been given permission to use CHSS for this 2 day (weekend) event. Still do not have a date as yet, but can only be as late as the 1st week in Aug or it will have to wait until the fall. He said that he has not had much luck in getting some known turners to participate.
 - The demo tonight was an Off Centered Winged Jar and this was given by Leo (thanks Leo for doing this). I must say that I have never seen a piece of wood that far off

centred in a lathe before, and it was hollowed. They look pretty neat.

- If anyone else would like to do a demo please don't hesitate to do one, you don't have to be Pro no one is going to criticise you. Its just nice to see someone else turn, and see their different techniques.
